  - Influenza Vaccinations (free to currently enrolled students)
  - Respiratory infections
  - Urinary tract infections
  - Pregnancy testing and referral, if needed
  - Gastro-intestinal complaints
  - Minor burns
  - Skin infections
  - Minor strains and sprains
  - Rashes
  - Testing for influenza, mono, strep
  - Random glucose testing
  - Cold and allergy
  - STI's (Sexually Transmitted Infections) are referred to the Lamar County Health Department for testing as a referral service.
  - HIV/AIDS testing are referred to the Lamar County Health Department. On-campus testing for HIV is conducted annually and sponsored by the Department of Public Health- District 4 at no cost for currently enrolled students.
